What is exactly the WTO?

- The only international organization for global trade rules to secure smooth & predictable trade flows. Governments negotiate rules and application, and sort out trade issues
- WTO Agreements: Trade in Goods, Trade in Services, Intellectual Property, Dispute settlement, Trade monitoring
- Technical assistance and training to build trade capacity in developing economies
- WTO is not just for liberalizing trade. In some circumstances its rules support
 maintaining trade barriers for example to protect consumers, prevent the spread of
 disease or protect the environment
- Mission: raising standards of living, ensuring full employment while allowing for the optimal use of the world's resources in accordance with objective of sustainable development

It's an inter-governmental organization, not a supra-national organization




